Re: AB 1970 (Jackson) Mental Health: Black Mental Health Navigator Certification Pilot Program – Support with amendments

Dear Chairwoman Bonta,

On behalf of the California State Association of Psychiatrists (CSAP), I write in support of AB 1970 and respectfully request that the bill language be amended from Mental Health to Behavioral Health.

AB 1970 would, commencing July 1, 2025, establish, until June 30, 2028, the Black Mental Health Navigator Certification Pilot Program, to be administered by the State Department of Health Care Services, to provide comprehensive training in mental health resources and awareness.

While CSAP supports the bill and its intentions, by changing the language to Behavioral Health it would be more inclusive and allow for a more accurate and comprehensive representation of the indidividuals the legislation is aimed at helping. Further, changing the wording to Behavioral Health mirrors other reforms taken by the Newsom Adminstration and the Legislature.

For these reasons, CSAP is pleased to support AB 1970 and respectfully requests that the bill be amended from Mental Health to Behavioral Health.
